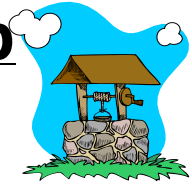

## LEARNING OUTCOMES

### PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL

- Building on confidence in situations & play with others.
- Talking about feelings, using words such as: Happy, Sad, Angry, Worried.
- Understanding Golden Rules.

### COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- Initiating a conversation with an adult or peer.
- Sing a repertoire of songs.
- Developing on listening & attention skills.
- Follow & understand instructions at 3 or 4 key word level.

### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Climb nursery apparatus & using alternate feet when going up and down stairs.
- Developing pencil / pen control skills.
- Using one handed tools correctly & safely.
- Working on independent skills, such as: pouring a drink, washing own hands & dressing self.

### UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

- Using all senses when using a 'hands on' approach when exploring materials.
- Talking about families & special events.
- Learn & talk about how to care for plants.
- Creating stories with small world toys.

### LITERACY

- Working on forming letters.
- Holding a book appropriately & turn the pages carefully.
- Engage in extended conversations about stories.
- Learning new vocabulary.
- Giving meaning to marks made.

### MATHEMATICS

- Reciting numbers past 5.
- Saying one number for each item in order.
- Recognising shapes in the environment.
- Taking part with number rhymes.

### EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

- Explore different materials freely to develop on own ideas about how to use them & what to make and create.
- Exploring colour and colour mixing.
- Using imaginative play & using resources to represent objects.
